

Request for Assessment Extension Form

The form must be submitted as soon as the circumstance is known and no later than the assessment due date/time.

The Subject Coordinator may approve extensions of up to two weeks (14 calendar days). The Subject Coordinator will consider the application and will communicate via your Institute email address to confirm the outcome. In addition to information required below, the subject Coordinator may also ask for evidence of progress and/or appropriate supporting documentation.

This process applies to assessment tasks other than examinations. This form does not replace the Special Consideration process.
